This vision has sparked a number of new initiatives that have created many positive changes. Just recently we had a ribbon cutting ceremony to introduce our newest acquisition, two new Hyperbaric Chambers for our Wound Care and Hyperbaric Center. This therapeutic service has achieved remarkable results for patients suffering from wounds which have not responded to traditional therapies. It saves limbs, and it saves lives. We also celebrated the opening of The Sleep Disorders Center at Long Beach Medical Center to help patients suffering from sleep disorders, which are not only disruptive to ones life but can be life threatening. We recently completed the first phase of the installation of a comprehensive hospital and nursing home information system that will transmit clinical information more expeditiously, improve efficiency and raise quality.

Our Diagnostic Imaging Department recently completed a two-year, \$4 million technology renovation, including the installation of a new MRI and multislice CT Scanner, 3-dimensional echocardiography for sophisticated heart studies, an advanced fluoroscopic imaging system and a new nuclear camera system that provides exquisite images for stress testing, bone scans and other nuclear exams.

Our highly regarded Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation Center will take a major step forward this summer when it opens a residency program in Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation to train physicians in this important specialty. Plans are also being finalized for our soon to open Stroke Center, Dialysis Center and a ventilator support unit for the Komanoff Center.

These advances and this commitment to the community could not have occurred without the enthusiasm and dedication of our professional staff and employees. Every day I read wonderful anecdotes from our patient satisfaction surveys and from letters about the extraordinary care that they've received. Their comments validate that our core values are not just words on a page but are being lived in all corners of the Medical Center. They represent a culture of caring that has become a hallmark of Long Beach Medical Center.
