



### **PATIENT/RESIDENT RESPONSIBILITIES STATEMENT:**

As a patient, resident, or client seeking services at Long Beach Medical Center, you are a partner in your care. You and your family have the following responsibilities:

- To provide accurate and complete information about your health, including your past illnesses, hospital stays and use of medicine.
- To tell you doctor and staff caring for you if there is a change in your condition or if you have a problem
- To follow the plan of care developed for you by your physician and other healthcare staff while you are an outpatient, inpatient or after discharge.
- To ask questions when you do not understand information or instructions
- To tell you doctor if you believe you can not follow the plan of care developed for you while an outpatient, inpatient or after discharge; to accept the consequences and outcomes of such decisions.
- To report any concerns you have about your safety while under our care.
- To provide accurate insurance information and to work with the Medical Center staff to arrange payment, when needed.
- To be considerate of the needs and property of other patients/residents, staff and the Medical Center.
- To follow the Medical Center's policies, including the No Smoking Policy.
- To be aware of the Medical Center's visiting hours and inform your visitors of this policy.
